ANY new business w fire risk these days needs to be very very far from homes and development! This space in south Orange County is not suitable for this facility as wildfire risk increases each year. It needs to be far away from homes and critical transportation arteries. This is a terrible idea and we object strongly. If there were a fire there it would surely close the critical main transportation artery in So CA for more than a day as that type of fire is not easy to extinguish. Too high a risk!!
