The use of the South Orange County Community College District and Saddleback College Workforce Learning Grant as Community Benefit is on its face a stretch because there is no clear guidance that the students and faculty who use this money are part of the affected Communities of San Juan Capistrano or Laguna Niguel and may not even benefit the community of Mission Viejo where the College is located. There is no guarantee these funds contribute to any source or business because this is not prescribed in the Grant documentation. It is very telling that the cities affected, Laguna Niguel and San Juan Capistrano, that are in opposition of this project, do not have any Community Benefit sources or funds as a designated part of this project. I would ask that the Commission reconsider this Community Benefit as an appropriate source and as the only benefit source offered so far, if you find it inappropriate, please deem the application as deficient and deny the Application.
