Even more troubling, the site has only one access point, through a railroad crossing with a documented history of accidents. According to Mayor Bourne and the Orange County Fire Authority, local firefighters strongly oppose this project due to the danger this creates in an emergency.

If this project is approved without resolving these critical safety issues, it will place both first responders and local residents at risk. This is not just about energy infrastructure — it's about responsible planning and community safety.

I respectfully urge you to reject this project until all environmental and emergency access concerns have been thoroughly addressed.
