The Public Records Act exempts from disclosure (1) information regarding Native American places, features, and objects and (2) archaeological site information and reports maintained by or in the possession of agencies. (See, Govt. Code §§ 7927.000, 7927.005.) The Public Records Act ("PRA") also provides a specific exemption from disclosure where "...on the facts of the particular case the public interest served by not disclosing the record clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure of the record." (Gov't Code § 7922.000.)

The Information is exempt from disclosure under these provisions as the appendices may contain information regarding both Native American places, features and objects, and archaeological site information and reports maintained as confidential by the California Office of Historic Preservation and California Department of Parks and Recreation. Further, the public interest in nondisclosure outweighs that of disclosure, as disclosure may enable the location of sensitive cultural and paleontological resources sites by thieves, vandals, or persons conducting unauthorized collection of materials.

4. State whether the information may be disclosed if it is aggregated with other information or masked to conceal certain portions, and if so the degree of aggregation or masking required.

The Applicant considered whether it would be possible to aggregate or mask the information. Figures and summaries depicting the substance of the Information have been provided as part of the Opt-In Application for Certification, but at a less granular level of detail. This facilitates an understanding of the types and general locations of the cultural and paleontological resources in the study area without disclosing specific site information. It is possible that certain portions of the Information may be publicly disclosed or redacted.

5. State whether and how the information is kept confidential by the applicant and whether it has ever been disclosed to a person other than an employee of the applicant, and if so under what circumstances.

The Information is accessible to employees or consultants working on behalf of the Applicant, certain professionals or entities that may otherwise have access to the Information, and
