None of the materials we request to be designated as confidential are suitable for aggregation. Any attempt at aggregation would likely result in the disclosure of confidential information.

The material has been kept confidential and has not been disclosed to any person other than CHEERS staff except where required by HERS Regulations.

The information is substantially similar to application materials previously designated as confidential under 22-HERS_01.
