Staff reviewed City of Glendale Water and Power's 2024 IRP filing for consistency with the requirements of Public Utilities Code section 9621. Based on staff's *Review of City of*

Glendale Water and Power 2024 IRP, the CEC Executive Director filed a determination on September 5, 2025, finding the City of Glendale Water and Power's 2024 IRP filing consistent with the requirements of Public Utilities Code section 9621. The CEC plans to consider adoption of the determination at the November 2025 Business Meeting.

Background

Public Resources Code sections 9621 requires publicly owned utilities (POUs) with an annual electric demand exceeding 700 gigawatt hours to adopt IRPs by January 1, 2019 and to update them at least once every five years thereafter. Public Resources Code section 9622 requires POU IRPs and any updates thereto to be submitted to the CEC for review. The CEC's [*Publicly Owned Utility Integrated Resource Plan Submission and Review Guidelines \(Revised Second Edition\)*](#), available on Docket 18-IRP-01, TN #224889, at <https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/getdocument.aspx?tn=224889>, govern the timing and procedures for submission of IRPs and IRP updates to the CEC.

IRPs are electricity system planning documents intended to ensure that POUs lay out the resource needs, policy goals, physical and operational constraints, and general priorities or proposed resource choices of an electric utility, including customer-side preferred resources. These plans will provide a framework to evaluate how utilities have chosen to align with greenhouse gas emission reduction targets as well as energy, climate, and other policy goals outlined in Senate Bill 350 (De León, Chapter 547, Statutes of 2015).
