Pursuant to Title 20, section 2505(a)(4), of the California Code of Regulations, Prairie Song Reliability Project, LLC (the “Applicant”) submits this Repeated Application for Confidential Designation for the following information submitted in support of the Opt-In Application for Certification for the Prairie Song Reliability Project (“PSRP”):

- Confidential Appendix 3.3A, Archaeological Resources Management Report, Appendix C, Cultural Resources Overview (Revised);
- Confidential Appendix 3.3A, Archaeological Resources Management Report, Appendix E, DPR Site Forms (Revised); and

With respect to the cultural resources document subject to this Repeated Application, Confidential Appendix 3.3A, Archaeological Resources Management Report, Appendix C, Cultural Resources Overview (Revised) and Confidential Appendix 3.3A, Archaeological Resources Management Report, Appendix E, DPR Site Forms (Revised) are revised versions of

the documents previously granted confidential designation. These documents are substantially similar to the previously submitted information, and all facts and circumstances relevant to the confidentiality of the information remain unchanged.

With respect to the transmission interconnection documents subject to this Repeated Application, Confidential Appendix 2C, Transmission Interconnection Documents (Separated Documents) contains identical documents to those previously submitted but separated into small files for ease of California Energy Commission Staff's review. These documents are substantially similar to the previously submitted information, and all facts and circumstances relevant to the confidentiality of the information remain unchanged.

The Applicant notes that portions of the documents above may contain general or other information that can be made publicly available or provided in a redacted version. If needed, the Applicant requests that California Energy Commission Staff work with the Applicant to prepare redacted versions of the documents identified above that can be made available for public disclosure.
