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UL 9540 CERTIFIED LFP BATTERIES ARE NOT SAFE

Many developers lean on the myth that UL9540 certified LFP are “safe”, will rarely burn, and if they do they will not spread to a neighboring container.

Yesterday September 23, 2025, there was a battery fire in Boulder City, Nevada at the Townsite Solar/ Battery Storage facility.

This facility uses Tesla Mega pack batteries, which are UL 9540 certified LFP.

Not only did they have a fire, it spread to a second battery container.

This one recent event dispels two myths commonly touted by BESS developers when discussing the safety of their proposed project.
