From what Iâ€™ve seen with other projects in other communities, the meeting will indeed be LOCAL and will be ALL DAY, from 9am to 9pm, giving everyone the opportunity to comment. You will also have the option of calling in your comment that day.

Iâ€™ve already submitted our 1,892 signatures on our Petitions of Protest to this docket.

Please DO NOT approve this project for our rural community of Acton. It will endanger residents due to the use of Lithium Iron Phosphate batteries which are toxic when burning and the developer is very likely to get sued because of negative health effects from the toxins. There are many open areas further north as the proposed project is near the CA 14 freeway, a very heavily traveled freeway; a drinking water source, Palmdale Lake, for the majority of Palmdale and when contaminated with the toxins of this project will create this community to have no water; Acton is considered a high fire zone so these catching on fire is not if, but when; and there is no guarantee that the power generated in Acton will stay in Acton. AGAIN- take it somewhere else.
