PLEASE DO NOT APPROVE this project for our rural community of Acton. It will endanger residents due to the batteries proposed for use in this project, which are toxic and will emit toxins when burning, and the developer is very likely to get sued because of negative, and potentially life threatening, health effects from these toxins. There are many open areas further north that would avoid the project being located near the CA 14 freeway, which is very heavily traveled and is crippling to Antelope Valley communities when closed. Placing it further north would also prevent it being in close proximity to a drinking water source, Palmdale Lake, which provides water to the community of Palmdale.
