Pursuant to the *Joint Order Partially Granting Applicants' Motion to Suspend and Further Orders* issued on March 20, 2025 ("March 20<sup>th</sup> Joint Order"), <sup>1</sup> Black Rock Geothermal LLC ("the Applicant"), provides this *Status Report No. 19* describing any new project-related developments during the pendency of the suspension period for the Application for Certification ("AFC") proceeding of the Black Rock Geothermal Project ("BRGP" or the "Project").

The Applicant continues to actively engage with the community regarding geothermal development in Imperial County, including:

- Chamber of Commerce for Greater Brawley honored BHE Renewables with 2025 Business of the Year for making tremendous impacts to Imperial Valley through their investments in renewable energy.
- Collaborated with the Sonny Bono National Wildlife Refuge, Brawley Union High School, and Quechan Tribe on a revegetation project at the refuge.
- Contributed over 300 volunteer hours in Imperial County.
