This is a 1,150 Million Watt BESS—THREE TIMES THE SIZE OF THE HUMIDOR BESS!

That's 70 acres of lithium iron phosphate batteries which will be in 2,035 shipping sizes containers.

And another 30 acres dedicated to their substation they will be also building.

That's about 100 acres of our agriculture zoned land now being covered in a dangerous and potentially toxic industrial project

We are in a Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone of rural east Acton! ^ ^

1) It will endanger residents using Lithium Iron Phosphate batteries which are toxic when burning

2) It will be developed in a Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone

3) It will devalue homes near the facility, making them difficult to sell

4) It will further affect fire insurance premiums and our ability to obtain insurance

5) It will force many residents into selling their homes to the developer

6) It will industrialize our rural community

7) It will cover 70 acres in 2,035 battery enclosures

9) It will store equal to 50% of the capacity of Diablo Canyon and San Onofre Power Plants
