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## **Acton Resident Against Prairie Song BESS Project**

I am against siting the Prairie Song BESS project in the Agriculturally zoned east side of Acton. We are already a very high fire zone. Situating 70 Acres of lithium ion phosphate batteries as is proposed in the Prairie Song project, will have many adverse impacts on this rural ranch area of LA County. First, we are not zoned for this industrial use, we are agriculturally zoned. It will devalue the homes in the area. The residents will not receive any benefit from the resiliency the batteries provide- the resiliency is ALL for the public who live in the LA Basin. All we will get is increased fire risk, devalued homes, destruction of our rural lifestyle.

The Prairie Song BESS battery storage project should be sited near where the wind or solar is generated- away from the public and residences. Lithium ion phosphate batteries storage facilities are NOT safe to be stored near the public- this has been shown time and time again when thermal run away occurs.

Acton is a significant ecological area- NOT an area to be irreversibly changed and harmed by siting battery storage facilities next to ranches and homes.
