The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a workshop to present staff's analysis of the performance of Demand Side Grid Support (DSGS) Program during the 2024 season, with a focus on the Storage Virtual Power Plant (VPP) performance, also referred to as Incentive Option 3. This analysis may inform potential modifications to the DSGS Program Guidelines.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Background

Assembly Bill 205 (Ting, Chapter 61, Statutes of 2022) created the DSGS Program as part of the Strategic Reliability Reserve. The DSGS Program compensates eligible and enrolled participants for

upfront capacity commitments and per-unit reductions in net energy load during extreme events achieved through reduced usage, use of backup generation, or both. On August 10, 2022, the CEC adopted the *Demand Side Grid Support (DSGS) Program Guidelines, First Edition*, to implement the DSGS Program. Participants enrolled 315 megawatts in the program to help meet grid needs during the September 2022 heatwave. On July 26, 2023, the CEC adopted the *Demand Side Grid Support (DSGS) Program Guidelines, Second Edition*, to address lessons learned from the summer 2022 program implementation and bring on more clean resources with expanded participation options, including a virtual power plant for behind-the-meter storage (Incentive Option 3). Summer 2024 was the first full program season for participation in Incentive Option 3.

This workshop will discuss staff's analysis of summer 2024 Incentive Option 3 performance data.
