**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
LATHROP IRRIGATION DISTRICT ATTESTING TO VERACITY OF THE
POWER SOURCE DISCLOSURE PROGRAM 2024 ANNUAL REPORT AND
POWER CONTENT LABEL PREPARED BY THE CALIFORNIA ENERGY
COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Lathrop Irrigation District ("LID" or "District") is a publicly owned electric utility providing electric utility services to residents and businesses within its service area that includes the River Islands Development;

WHEREAS, the District is required to provide to its customers an annual Power Content Label, which will be generated by the California Energy Commission, and publish the same on the District website (as provided by California Code of Regulations, Title 20, Division 2, Chapter 3, Article 5, Section 1393.1)¹;

WHEREAS, the District is required to produce an Annual Report for submission to the California Energy Commission that provides details as to the District's retail sales, power procurement, and greenhouse gas emissions associated with its power procurement (as provided by Section 1393);

WHEREAS, the District timely submitted its Annual Report on June 2, 2025;

WHEREAS, a retail supplier of electric services which is a public agency is allowed to submit an attestation of the veracity of the Annual Report and Power Content Label in lieu of an audit (as provided by Section 1394(a)(2));

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Directors of the Lathrop Irrigation District as follows:

Section 1. APPROVALS. The Board of Directors hereby approves and

authorizes the District's 2024 Power Content Label prepared by the California Energy Commission; and,

further attests pursuant to Section 1394, Subdivision (a)(2), under penalty of perjury, that the information contained in the Annual Report submitted to the California Energy Commission on June 2, 2025, and Power Content Label attached hereto is true and correct to the best of the Board's knowledge;

Section 2. OFFICIAL ACTIONS. The President Vice President, the Treasurer, the Secretary , and all other proper officers of the District are hereby authorized and directed to take actions and do all things necessary or desirable to facilitate the execution and implementation of this resolution, including execution of an attestation regarding the veracity of the annual Power Source Disclosure report, as required by Section 1394(a)(2);

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Directors.

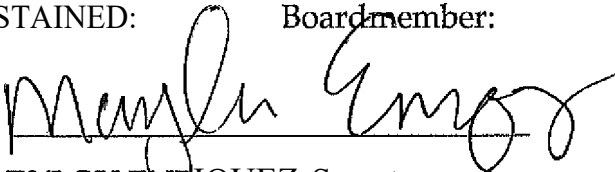
