## **Objection and Concern for our Vacaville Community**

As a long-time Vacaville resident, I am writing to express my strong opposition to the proposed CORBY Battery Storage System at Kilkenny & Byrnes Road. I have lived in this community for many years, and one of the things I value most is the sense of safety, peace, and natural beauty that surrounds our neighborhoods. The idea of placing a large-scale battery storage system right in our front yard is deeply concerning. These facilities carry risks of fire, chemical leaks, and explosions, and it is unacceptable to place families, children, and homes in harm's way. Beyond the safety issues, such an industrial project would disrupt the character of our community, threaten the environment, and lower the property values that so many of us have worked hard to build. What makes this especially difficult is that residents have not been meaningfully included in the decision-making process, even though we are the ones who will have to live with the consequences. Vacaville is a special place, and we deserve better than to become the testing ground for a hazardous project like this. I strongly urge the California Energy Commission to reject this application and to seek out safer, more appropriate locations far away from residential neighborhoods.
