Dear Commissioners,

My concern for the current Corby Battery Energy Storage System BESS continues to weigh on my heart in concern for the residents who live in the area of Kilkenny and Byrnes Road in Vacaville and I thank the CEC for raising an alternative to instruct NextEra to move the project to Lambie.

The current site at Kilkenny and Byrnes Road is a safety hazard to residents in the area and will be a disaster if/when there is a fire at the BESS facility. It has happened at other sites and will be an issue with this site at some time in the future undoubtedly.

The Lambie site is safer and industrially zoned for this type of project. NextEra's own analysis confirmed that Lambie Industrial Park is feasible, but object due to longer transmission lines needed and I assume an increase in cost to build at this safer site.

Solano County has passed an ordinance to stop this project but has been overrun by bills the State of California continues to pass to allow this BESS site on prime farmland at the expense of residents in the area.

Please move this Corby project to the Lambie Industrial Park site and save residents lives from toxic chemicals and all of the other hazards when the fire occurs.
