Small edits to the ZOOM transcript audio/video of agenda item 1 and 8, public commenter, Claire Zuma, for the California Energy Commission Business Meeting of October 9th, 2025

ZOOM often seems to mess with words, similar to auto-correct in text messaging. This time, ZOOM substituted close-sounding, relevant-sounding words which might mess with others badly. Therefore, I screenshot my comments [following] from yesterday's meeting, redlined what I noticed as being enough off to want to submit these corrections to the docket. I am certain not everyone involved has time, energy and patience to do this. Some might just let things like this "fly." I might too often and usually do not check ZOOM transcripts much. ZOOM transcripts can be ludicrous. However, some people relished not believing that I can be accurate and/or relevant, because errors make my professionalism less likely and gathers data for beliefs in mental health. Some might make similar mischief replacing words without automation. Yet, when items are slightly off, e.g., blood pressure readings, heights of poles/conductors and measurements on construction maps, due to other industry automated device mishaps, other serious problems can happen involving more people. It made sense [to me] today, to spend a little time sharing these few small Zoom transcript edits. Machines can be faster at making mischief, in mysterious block-chaining-like ways, without recourse. I missed the meeting having a human professional, hired transcript secretary, as in the distant past, seeing ZOOM transcript errors.
