

Ordinance amending Chapter 12.16 and Chapter 12.18 of Title 12 (Buildings and Construction) of the Menlo Park Municipal Code to adopt local amendments to the 2022 California Building Standards Code to include energy performance standards that apply to single family residential buildings that are undertaking construction projects within Menlo Park.

Reasons why project is exempt:

California Environmental Quality Act applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The ordinance is exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15307 and 15308 as an action by a regulatory agency taken to protect the environment and natural resources. The ordinance is exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301(a) because the ordinance does not result in an expansion of use. This ordinance is more protective of the environment than the state standards, so there is no possibility that the ordinance will have a significant effect on the environment. The ordinance helps the City of Menlo Park to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement and protection of the environment and the City of Menlo Park's natural resources by requiring energy efficiency standards for existing building remodels and installation of energy efficient cooling systems when cooling systems are being installed.
