I am writing to strongly urge the Commission to require the relocation of the Corby Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) Project from its currently proposed site near our agricultural land and residential community to the Lambie Industrial Park—a far more suitable and safer alternative.

It has come to our attention that the CEC recently asked the applicant, NextEra, whether relocation was feasible, and they confirmed that the Lambie Industrial Park site is indeed a viable option. Despite this, the applicant opposes the move, citing minor logistical inconveniences like a slightly longer transmission line or administrative delays.

These concerns are negligible when compared to the risks of siting a large-scale energy storage facility so close to agricultural land and homes. The proposed location presents unacceptable threats to public safety, land preservation, and long-term community well-being. In contrast, Lambie Industrial Park is already designated for industrial use, has the necessary infrastructure, and would prevent the needless sacrifice of prime farmland.

As a concerned member of this community, I ask that the Commission prioritize public safety, environmental stewardship, and responsible planning over developer convenience. The community has made its position clear: we support clean energy, but not at the cost of our agricultural resources or residential safety.

Please demonstrate your commitment to thoughtful, community-focused decision-making by directing the applicant to move the Corby BESS Project to the Lambie Industrial Park.
