Thank you for addressing the alternative location at Lambie Industrial Park. As you know, the Lambie location is a more suitable location because it is further from homes, schools and I-80. In addition, it is already zoned for industrial use.

Recent fires at battery storage facilities exemplify the need to have these facilities in areas that are away from populated areas. These toxic fires can burn for days, harming people's health, risking lives of first responders, closing throughways, harming the environment to name a few. Moving the BESS to Lambie significantly reduces the risk of impact from a thermal runaway incident.

NextEra's own analysis confirmed Lambie Industrial Park is feasible and meets their core project goals. Their objections are based on minor logistical "inconvenience," not genuine impossibility.

The applicant has two solutions: a longer gen-tie line (transmission line) or modifying some paperwork to change the interconnection point to make this new site work.

If moving the project causes a short delay (e.g., up to six months), it is a small price to pay for a responsibly sited, long-term project that protects our community for the next 30 years.

Please use your authority to ensure this BESS facility is built in Lambie Industrial Park. Clean energy is also safe energy.
