Subject: Comments on the Magnolia Power Project (01-AFC-06C) CEC Staff Analysis of Petition to Amend the Final Commission Decision for Efficiency Upgrades (TN 266274)

CEC Staff,

The Southern California Public Power Authority and the City of Burbank appreciate the CEC Staff's efforts in reviewing the Petition to Amend for the Magnolia Power Project (01-AFC-06C) and offer the following minor editorial comments for consideration regarding the Magnolia Power Plant (01-AFC-06C) CEC Staff Analysis of Petition to Amend the Final Commission Decision Efficiency Upgrades docketed on October 2, 2025.

For simplicity, comment page numbers are referenced to the page count on the Portable Document Format (PDF) and not the number at the bottom of the page.

- Page 1 and Page 6, first paragraph, first sentence– The Petition to Amend was docketed on December 23, 2024. Please change the references to December 31, 2024, on Pages 2 and 6 (of the pdf) to December 23, 2024.
- Page 10, Subsection Air Quality, paragraph 1 – The discussion of the increase in electrical production in this paragraph is inconsistent with Table 1 on page 7. This paragraph also references “footnote 2” but none exists. Please revise this paragraph to be consistent with Table 1 and correct the reference to “footnote 2”.
- Page 11, Subsection Efficiency – The heading of this Subsection is spelled incorrectly.
- Page 19, Subsection CEC Staff Recommendations and Conclusions, fourth paragraph, first sentence – Please update this section to reflect the South Coast Air

Quality Management District's October 16, 2025 Permit to Construct (Transaction Number 266758).

- Page 28, Subsection Operation, first paragraph, first sentence– The existing heat rate of 1,783 MMBtu/hr is incorrect. The correct value is 1,787 MMBtu/hr. Please correct accordingly.
- For consistency, throughout the Staff Analysis, consider referring to the SCAQMD MPP permit to operate as the “*SCAQMD Facility Permit to Operate*”.

We request that these comments be considered as part of the official record for this proceeding. Please let us know if any additional information or clarification is needed.
