Dear Vacaville City Council Members,

My name is Frances Ray, and I have been a proud resident of Vacaville since 2016. I am also a mother of two young children, both under the age of six. My family and I have built our lives here, and I have always envisioned raising my children in this beautiful community, surrounded by safety, stability, and opportunity.

I am writing to express my strong opposition to the proposed Corby Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) project in Vacaville. While I understand the need for sustainable energy solutions, the proposed project poses serious concerns for public safety, environmental health, and the well-being of local families.

My primary concerns include the following:

#### 1. Public Health and Safety Risks

The facility's proximity to residential neighborhoods and a Level II trauma center hospital presents a clear danger in the event of fire, explosion, or chemical release. #### 5. Local Control and Regulatory Concerns

The project's use of **Assembly Bill 205's (AB205) opt-in program** appears to be an attempt to circumvent local review and public input. This undermines the ability of our community and elected officials to ensure that development aligns with Vacaville's safety standards and long-term planning goals. It's also worth noting that there is currently an active moratorium on battery energy storage projects while regulations are still being developed — yet this proposal is moving forward in spite of that.

Vacaville is a growing and vibrant city that should continue to prioritize families, safety, and environmental stewardship. Projects like this threaten the very qualities that make our town special and will undoubtedly deter new families and businesses from calling Vacaville home.
