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Putah Fan Aquifer Groundwater Sustainability Plan

Greetings,

I have concerns regarding the location of the Corby Battery Storage Facility at the corner of Kilkenny and Byrnes Roads.

Vacaville's Water System Map (attached) shows that there are multiple City of Vacaville Water Wells in the Ground Water Putah Fan Aquifer at this location. The inherent risk this presents does not appear to have been addressed. City of Vacaville, Solano County and any others should review their Groundwater Sustainability Plans.

Statement that new design "prevents" thermal runaway and fire risk. Need to confirm new plans includes fire suppression system and structure modifications to minimize fire spread if prevention measures don't work.

Minimum required set back of 300' from hospitals, schools, homes and other sensitive sites (jet fuel pipeline) is not adequate.

Given that the SFPUC intends to buy all of the stored power from the new facility, a better location would be near the Moccasin Hydro Plant Site that the SFPUC already owns and maintains. It is in an unpopulated area and there are already existing SFPUC Transmission Lines that feed Hetch Hetchy and Moccasin Hydro Power to the San Francisco Peninsula.
