Due to work obligations I was unable to attend the 11/6 meeting. I just want my voice to be heard so I am submitting my strong opposition to the lithium-ion battery/Corby project being considered in Vacaville now. We are a rural community. Our AG land, water, air quality, citizens and first responders all need to be protected from the toxins this plant will release should a fire occur. What will happen if Travis AFB is exposed on a windy day? I doubt our military will be permitted to shelter in place! Our firefighters won't be able to safely protect us - they will have to just let it burn for days. If there is any wind (and there often times is at the proposed site), Vacaville will not be the only community at risk. Nearby Dixon, Elmira, Rio Vista, etc could also be at risk. Additionally, home insurance will increase and property values will decrease.
