Constellation NewEnergy, Inc., ("CNE") respectfully requests protection of certain information provided to the Commission in its accompanying Electricity Resource Planning Forms submission.

Information submitted to the Energy Commission may be deemed confidential without the need for a new application under California Code of Regulations, Title 20, Sections 2505(a)(1)(G) and 2505(a)(4) if CNE files a certification under penalty of perjury that the new information is substantially similar to the information previously granted confidentiality. By letter dated December 5, 2024 (see Attachment A hereto) you approved CNE's request for confidential designation for information submitted in CNE's 2024 IEPR Electricity Resource Planning submission in Docket 24-IEPR-02.

CNE's 2025 IEPR Electricity Resource Planning Forms submission contains information that is substantially similar to its previously submitted 2024 IEPR Electricity Resource Planning Forms, and information and all facts and circumstances relevant to the confidentiality of the information remain unchanged.

We bring to the Commission's attention, however, two pieces of newly added data for which CNE has not previously requested confidentiality in this context, but for which confidentiality was granted in another Commission proceeding. CNE requests confidential designation for data on Form S-2, Line 8, Short-Term and Spot Market Energy Supply Purchases (and Sales) for years 2023 and 2024 in cells AC78 and AD78. CNE requests confidentiality for this information because if left unredacted would reveal sufficient information to illuminate CNE's confidential retail load and supply balance information. By letter dated August 12, 2025 (see Attachment B hereto) you approved CNE's request for confidential designation for this spot

market procurement data in CNE's 2024 Power Source Disclosure Annual Report submission in Docket 25-PSDP-01, albeit for a shorter period of time than being requested now.
