The development of battery storage is vital to our current grid, but there are safer alternatives to lithium ion batteries and more importantly, there are safer locations for these facilities.

The current proposals place multiple facilities in Vacaville, near schools, hospitals and next to existing neighborhoods. Vacaville is known for being hot and windy and that alone should be a primary consideration for these highly flammable batteries. These facilities bring a high level of risk to a high risk environment. If the current proposal continues and California decides they choose profit over people, we too shall leave, taking our family and taxes outside of California.
