Dear Commissioners,

My name is Nate Robertson and I'm writing today to urge you to reject the Corby BESS project. This facility is being placed far too close to neighborhoods, farmland, and major roadways. Even "safer" LFP batteries still pose serious risks; each container holds tens of thousands of pounds of hazardous material, and one fire could send toxic gases toward nearby homes within minutes.

We still don't have clear answers on emergency alerts, evacuation timing, or who will pay for cleanup if contamination spreads beyond the site. Without an independent cleanup fund and a truly reliable safety plan, this project puts local residents at unacceptable risk.

This location is simply the wrong place for a high-hazard industrial facility. I respectfully ask that the Commission deny this project at this location.
