Dear Jonathan Johnson:

On September 18, 2025, National Energy Testing Institute, Inc. doing business as Golden State Registry (GSR), submitted applications to be certified as an Energy Code Compliance (ECC) Provider under California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Section 10-103.3, and as a residential data registry, under the 2025 Energy Code.

Energy Code regulations regarding the application process (Title 24, Part 1, Section 10-110(a)) say that the CEC's executive director "shall determine if the application is complete" within 75 days of receipt. Staff has reviewed the application materials submitted to docket 25-BSTD-01 and finds the applications to be incomplete at this time.

For ECC-Provider and residential data registry applications to be considered complete, National Energy Testing Institute, Inc. should include the remaining information for the following application categories detailed in Attachment A:

- ECC- Provider Application – Introduction and Identification
- ECC- Provider Application – Detailed Explanations
- ECC- Provider Application – Additional Exhibits
- ECC- Provider Application – Detailed 10-103.3(d)1 Responsibilities
- ECC- Provider Application – Title 24, Part 6 Responsibilities and Protocols.
- Residential Data Registry Application – Introduction
- Residential Data Registry Application – Registry Description

Please review Attachment A for an extensive list of requirements that staff has deemed to be incomplete.

The application approval process cannot proceed until these deficiencies have been addressed and (if needed) revised application materials have been submitted to the 25-BSTD-01 docket.
