SUMMARY OF POST CERTIFICATION PETITION PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION CHANGE **ELK HILLS POWER PLANT** (99-AFC-01C)

On October 10, 2025, the California Resources Corporation (CRC) filed a Post-Certification Petition for Changes in Project Design, Operation or Performance and Amendments to the Commission Decision (Petition) (TN 266900)¹ with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Elk Hills Power Plant (EHPP) pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1769.

The EHPP, a 550-megawatt (MW) combined-cycle, cogeneration natural gas facility was certified by the CEC in December 2000 and began commercial operation in July 2003. The facility is located at the CRC oil and gas field near the community of Tupman in Kern County.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

The project owner seeks approval to construct and operate a carbon capture unit to capture and store carbon dioxide (CO2) emissions from the EHPP and then transport the CO2 through a proposed approximately 2,200-foot pipeline, collectively known as the Cal Capture Carbon Capture and Seguestration (CCS) Project. The Cal Capture CCS Project would connect to a pipeline header approved by Kern County in 2024 as part of the Carbon Terra Vault I (CTV I) project (State Clearinghouse No. 2022030180) for underground injection using the previously approved CTV I project U.S. Environmental Protection Agency

REVIEW PROCESS

This petition is reviewed pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1769. The review process includes an evaluation of the effect the change could have on the environment; the project's compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, or standards; and whether a change to, or deletion of any condition of certification adopted by the CEC in the final decision or subsequent amendments is required.

After staff completes an independent review and analysis of this petition, the assessment will be published for public review and comment. Included in the staff analysis, will be written notice of staff's intent to either process the proposed changes as a staff-approved project change or schedule it for consideration by the CEC at a regularly scheduled business meeting.
