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STATEMENT OF STAFF APPROVAL CHANGE IN OWNERSHIP AND OPERATIONAL CONTROL PROCTOR & GAMBLE POWER PLANT (93-AFC-02C)

On November 24, 2025, the Sacramento Municipal Utility District Financing Authority (SFA), the project owner, filed a post certification petition with the California Energy Commission (CEC) requesting to transfer ownership of the Proctor & Gamble Power Plant (PGPP) from SFA to the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD), the new owner.

The 171-megawatt project was certified by the CEC in November 1994 and began commercial operation in March 1997. The PGPP is located at 5000 83rd Street in Sacramento.

A statement describing the change in ownership and operational control, signed under penalty of perjury by Lourdes White, Senior Attorney for SMUD, was submitted pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 1769(b) and 1707. The statement affirms that the new project owner understands the conditions of certification in the Commission Decision or as previously amended and agrees to comply with those conditions.

Staff has reviewed the petition and has determined that the petition meets the requirements of California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 1769(b). Accordingly, staff hereby approves the petition to change ownership and operational control for the PGPP.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any person may file an objection to a staff approval within 14 days of the filing of staff's statement. Any such objection must state the grounds for the objection. If a person files such an objection, the petition shall be considered by the CEC at a noticed business meeting or hearing.
