Proposed Language

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Proposed Regulation Overview



Section 1396.1. Title and Scope.

- Proposed requirements apply to:
 - all heating, AC and water heating equipment covered by Title 20 (Sections 1601(b), (c), (e), (f));
 - all sales of equipment, including but not limited to: manufacturers to distributors, distributors to wholesalers, wholesalers to retailers, retailers to installers / users, etc.
- Proposed exclusions are:
 - Portable air conditioners, evaporative coolers, fans, dehumidifiers, and air filters (Section 1601(d))



Section 1396.2. Rules of Construction and Definitions.

- Seven proposed definitions:
 - Three agency names;
 - “Contractor” specified to have its statutory definition;
 - “Receiving entity” is someone to whom equipment is sold;
 - “Installer” means someone who installs equipment;
 - “Private User” means someone who benefits from installed equipment that is not an installer.



Section 1396.3. Reporting Periods and Requirements.

- Proposed reporting frequency is quarterly
- Proposed reporting format is via a comma-separated-value (*.csv) file
- Executive Director can update format



Section 1396.4. Data to be Reported.

- Proposed data collection falls into two types: equipment and buyer
- Equipment data proposed to include:
 - Make / brand
 - Model number
 - Serial number
- Buyer data proposed to include:
 - Name and billing address
 - Business ID number (if a business)
 - Contractor ID number (if a contractor)
- Received data will also be associated with the reporting seller



Section 1396.5. Data Access.

- Reported data will be confidential
- CEC may publicly release data in an aggregated or anonymized form that prevents associating sales data to a specific entity, installation of a unit to a specific address, or prevalence of a specific brand or model number of equipment.



Section 1396.6. Enforcement

- CEC has authority to enforce in Public Resources Code section 25321
 - This section applies when data is not provided or willfully false
 - This section specifies \$500-\$2000 per data category, per day



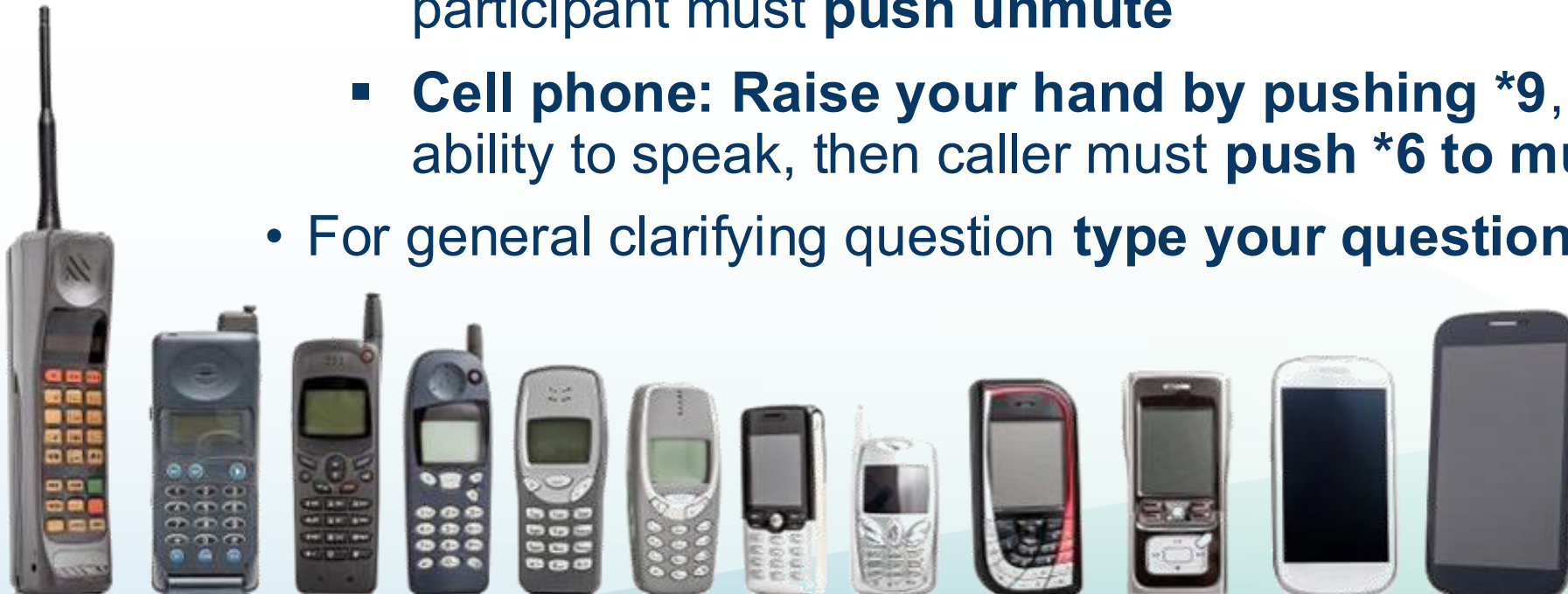
