The California Energy Commission (CEC), California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and California Air Resources Board (CARB) will host a joint two-part workshop to present and discuss the draft electricity resource modeling results and implementation challenges for the Senate Bill (SB) 100 (de Leon, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) Joint Agency Report. This is a hybrid meeting consistent with Senate Bill 189 (Committee on Budget and Fiscal Review, Chapter 48, Statutes of 2022), with both a publicly accessible physical location and public access online or by phone through Zoom™.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

In the morning, joint agency staff will present electricity resource modeling results to inform the draft SB 100 Report. In the afternoon, invited representatives from interested organizations will

participate in a moderated panel discussing challenges and opportunities associated with implementing the policy.

Background

The 100 Percent Clean Energy Act of 2018 (SB 100, De León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) establishes a target for renewable and zero-carbon resources to supply 100 percent of retail sales and electricity procured to serve all state agencies by 2045. SB 100 requires the CEC, CPUC, and CARB to develop and submit a joint-agency report to the legislature by January 1, 2021, and at least every four years thereafter. The requirement is codified in the [Public Utilities Code Section 454.53](#), and the full text is available at https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC§ionNum=45.53.

The electricity resource modeling and implementation challenges discussed at this workshop is intended to inform the forthcoming 2025 SB 100 Joint Agency Report.
