## **Formal Opposition to Proposed Corby battery energy storage system Project in Vacaville Ca**

Dear California Energy Commission,

I am writing to formally express my strong opposition to the proposed Lithium-Ion Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) project in the city of Vacaville. As a resident of Vacaville, I believe the potential risks to public safety, environmental health, and quality of life far outweigh any benefits of this facility.

My opposition is based on the following critical concerns:

**Unacceptable Safety Risks:** The risk of "thermal runaway" in large-scale lithium-ion systems is a severe hazard. These fires are notorious for being difficult to control, spreading quickly, and releasing toxic gases like hydrogen fluoride into the air, creating a severe public health hazard for residents in Vacaville.

**Inadequate Emergency Response Capability:** Our local fire department is not equipped, nor properly trained to handle a large-scale chemical fire of this magnitude. Allowing this facility places an unfair burden on first responders and risks the safety of our community.

**Environmental and Water Safety:** The project's proximity to the north bay aquaduct poses a high risk of contamination from toxic fire residue and runoff.

**Impact on Neighborhood Quality of Life:** The continuous, 24/7 industrial noise from cooling fans will negatively impact the surrounding residential area. Not to mention the hospital that is only miles from the proposed location.

A project with these potential risks does not belong in a residential area, especially this close to a hospital. I urge the board to prioritize the safety and well-being of its citizens in Vacaville and reject this application.
