RE: Sierra Club Request for Written Comment Extension on the SB 100 Draft Results Workshop

Dear Commissioners,

We appreciate the opportunity for stakeholders and communities to participate in the California Energy Commission’s (“CEC”) public comment process for the SB 100 Draft Results Workshop, but request that the Commission extend the written comment deadline by two weeks to allow stakeholders to access modeling data and better respond to the Commission’s draft results.

The Commission first shared the SB 100 draft results via slides on February 18, 2026, the day before the public workshop. At the workshop, stakeholders requested the underlying modeling data leading to the Draft Results, but as of the date of this letter, that data has not been provided on the docket. During the workshop, CEC staff made clear that this was the one and only comment opportunity before the 2025 SB 100 Report goes to the Commission for approval.

Stakeholders need more data and more time to provide meaningful feedback on these draft results. Sierra Club asks that the CEC provide the modeling data to stakeholders via the public docket as soon as possible. In addition, Sierra Club asks that the Commission extend the deadline for written comments on the SB 100 Draft Results by two weeks to March 19, 2026.

We appreciate the CEC’s diligence and commitment in facilitating an inclusive and transparent public engagement process in steering the renewable energy transition in California.
