Opposition to the Prairie Song Reliability Project

I would like to express to the commission my total opposition to the Praise Song project

I believe that this facility would greatly increase the fire danger in an area that is already rated as extreme risk for fire with fire insurance for residents outrageously expensive or impossible to get.

The water sources for fire fighting are very limited and the proposed on site storage is certainly not enough to handle a battery fire.

In the event of fire even if there was a sufficient water source the runoff from the fire fighting would flow into the nearby river bed and the toxic chemicals would most certainly contaminate the drinking water used by most local residents.

The Acton community does not receive benefit from the stored power so the risk is not outweighed by any benefit.

Any jobs created will likely not be filled by Acton residents and those same jobs would be available if the facility was built farther out in un-populated areas of the desert such as areas east of Mojave where the solar farms already exist.
