## **23-SB-100 - 100% Clean Energy for California**

I urge the state to aim for 100% clean energy in terms of generation, rather than the state's incorrect interpretation of retail sales. If the state does not include transmission, distribution, and storage losses in its definition of 100% clean energy, we will be missing out on decarbonizing a critical percentage of the grid and will be keeping some polluting fossil fuels online.

I am also very concerned about increased electric load due to data centers coming to California. Demand forecasts need to be accurately projected and not overstated, reflecting the probability of projects completing, their total loads, supply constraints, and timing of load growth. The demand from data centers must not prevent California from meeting its clean energy goals in an affordable and equitable way.
