Comment on 2025 SB 100 Draft Joint Agency Report

1. Please let us read and comment on the entire draft report. A bunch of slides is really not enough.
2. Carbon Capture and Sequestration and Hydrogen are false solutions. They are expensive and energy intensive and do not provide a pathway to ending our dependence on fossil fuels.
3. Along those lines, we need a plan that takes us to a point where we no longer have any gas power plants running in California.
4. Batteries have come way down in price and are an exciting technology for long duration storage. It's great to see battery discharge replacing fossil fuel combustion at critical times of the day.
5. We need to put more emphasis on demand response programs which are especially important for reducing peaks and increasing reliability. Not everything needs to be utility scale. It would be great to see local generation through microgrids, community solar, solar plus battery, vehicle to grid etc. given more prominence and included in resource adequacy planning.
