ITEM 8, Senate Bill (SB) 1221 (Min, Chapter 602, Statutes of 2024) Implementation. CPUC staff to present and seek feedback on the

ITEM 9, Energy Disconnections and Reconnections (Disconnections) Rulemaking (R.18-07-005). CPUC staff to present and seek feedback on the Disconnections rulemaking, including whether and how to adjust disconnection caps and recommendations related to pilot programs on Arrearage Management Plans (AMPs), Percentage of Income Payment Plans (PIPPs), and Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) currently scheduled to sunset in 2026. Staff will also seek input on recommendations to minimize impacts to vulnerable customers given high statewide arrearages if pilots were allowed to sunset as scheduled and disconnection caps were modified, such as coordination between Investor-Owned Utilities (IOUs) and other entities to support customers at risk of disconnection.
