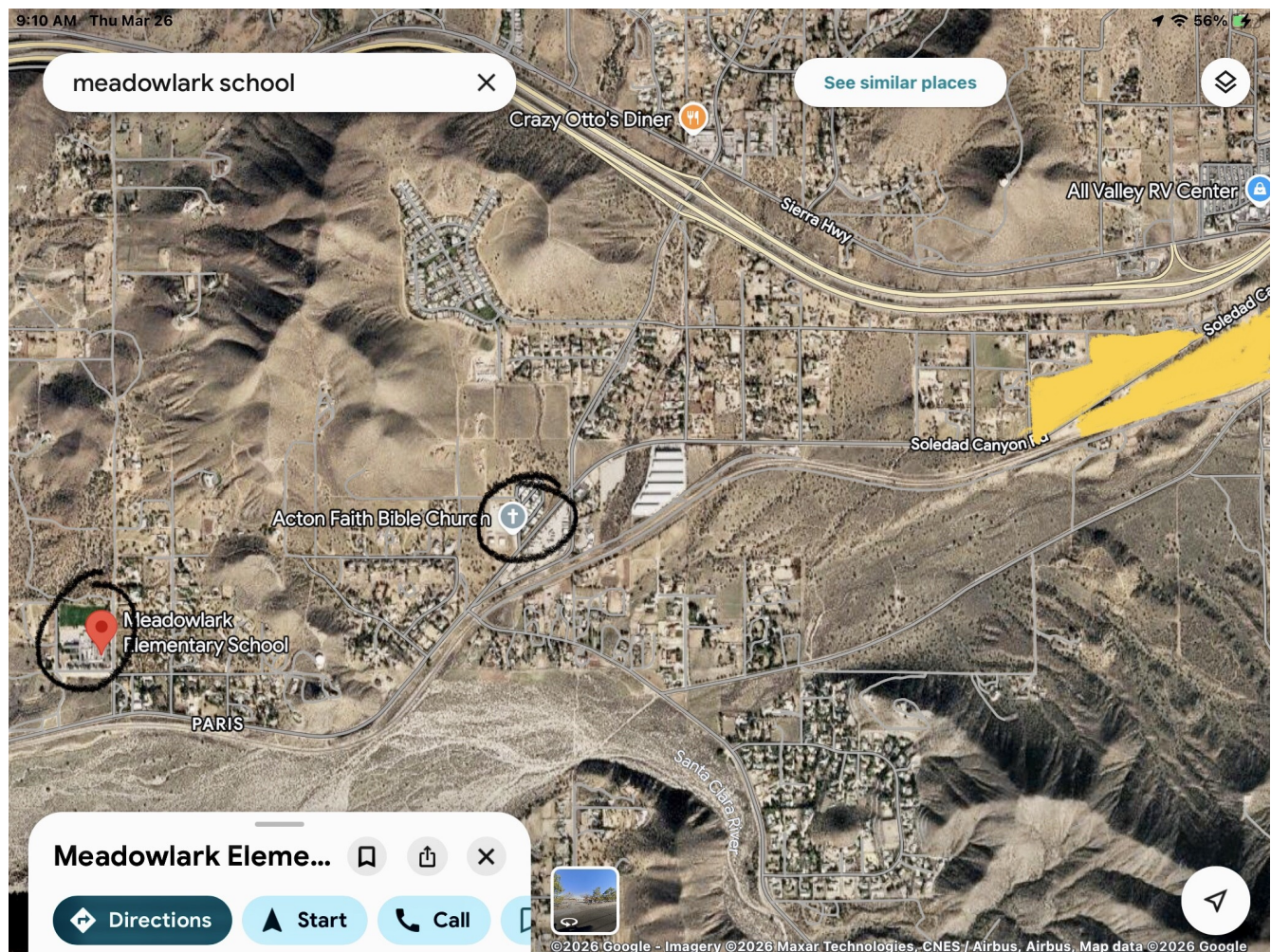
I wish to correct Dudek and Coval on the subject of sensitive receptors which were identified in Data Response #6 , Section 4 - Neighboring Uses (page 6). Dudek/Coval identified the nearest school as being Meadowlark Elementary which is 2 miles away from the PSRP. This is incorrect.

On 9/15/25 there was a submission to the docket by Acton Faith Bible Church (TN 266015) which stated there is a planned and *approved* school which will be part of Acton Faith Bible Church which is much closer to the Project than Meadowlark Elementary School.

We are very concerned about the Prairie Song battery facility planned for Soledad Canyon Rd. Acton Faith Bible Church has approved plans for a school on our property on Gem Way, quite close to these proposed facilities. Catastrophic failure in these systems in the past (Moss Landing, e.g.) have led to dangerous levels of toxic fumes unleashed into the air. This area is also a High Risk area for wildfires due to desert brush and high winds. We believe this project needs to be a safe distance from homes, schools and churches rather than in our semi-rural family oriented community. Thank you! --- Rev. Wayne A. Wilson
