ECC Rater Responsibilities

I appreciate the effort that Energy CODE Ace team has made in synchronizing the Building Code so that each section is congruent throughout (i.e., the 100-Section is always the DEFINITIONS Section).

I also appreciate that fact that Energy CODE Ace provides great resources and references in understanding the CODE.

What is lacking is getting information out to Architects and General Contractors. For example, when I go to renew my CSLB License there are no CEU's required to verify if I am up-to-date on the 3-Yr. cycle of the Building CODE. This puts the responsibility to inform builders of the enforcement of the CODE Changes on the ECC Raters (i.e., MECH-32 Range Hood Ventilation Certification; OR "Insulated Headers" to meet the QII Criteria.) Lastly, there is inconsistency in AHJ's enforcement of the CALGREEN M A N D A T O R Y Measures. Many AHJ's simply ignore the CALGREEN MANDATORY Measures.
