ITEM 5: Energy Disconnections and Reconnections (Disconnections) Rulemaking (R.18-07-005). CPUC staff will briefly recap the presentation from the February 20, 2026, meeting and seek feedback from the DACAG including whether and how to adjust disconnection caps and recommendations related to pilot programs on Arrearage Management Plans (AMPs), Percentage of Income Payment Plans (PIPPs), and the Arrears Case Management Pilot Program currently scheduled to sunset in 2026. Staff will also seek input on ways to minimize impacts to vulnerable customers given high statewide arrearages if pilots were allowed to sunset as scheduled and disconnection caps were modified, such as coordination between Investor-Owned Utilities (IOUs) and other entities to support customers at risk of disconnection.

ITEM 6: Gas Research, Development, and Demonstration (Gas RD&D) Program. As it relates to the DACAG priority areas of Building, Industrial, Gas System Decarbonization, and Clean Renewable Hydrogen; Long-term Planning for Natural Gas; and the Electric Program Investment Charge Program (EPIC) (related to the coordinated role of gas), the Gas RD&D administrators of the CEC, Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E), and Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) will present and seek feedback from the DACAG on coordinated Gas RD&D investment proposals to be funded by ratepayers. DACAG input will inform investment concepts amounting to approximately \$50 million across their respective proposed Annual Gas RD&D Plans to be submitted to the CPUC by June 1, 2026.
