**RE: Application for Confidential Designation: Community Benefits Agreement  
Docket No. 24-OPT-04: Potentia-Viridi Battery Energy Storage System**

Dear Mr. Bohan,

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 20, Section 2505, Levy Alameda, LLC, the applicant for the Potentia-Viridi Battery Energy Storage System Project (“Project”), submits this Application for Confidential Designation to the California Energy Commission (“CEC”) regarding certain information contained within the Community Benefits Agreement between the Applicant and Tri-Valley Haven for Women, as detailed further below.

To support the Application for Confidential Designation, the following information is provided in accordance with 20 CCR section 2505.

**1. Contact Information**

**2. Title, date, and description (including number of pages) of the information or data for which you request confidential designation.**

- Project Support Agreement between Levy Alameda, LLC, and Tri-Valley Haven for Women, dated October 13, 2025 (10 pages)
  - Requesting confidential designation of certain provisions of the agreement, which include contact information and the monetary values for each project support payment

**3. Specify the part(s) of the information or data for which you request confidential designation.**

The Applicant requests that contact information and the monetary values for each project support payment within the Project Support Agreement be kept confidential. A redacted version of the Project Support Agreement will be added to the Project docket.

**4. State and justify the length of time the CEC should keep the information or data confidential.**

The Applicant requests that the information referenced in Response No. 3 be kept confidential indefinitely.

**5. Cite and discuss the provisions of the Public Records Act or other law that allow the Commission to keep the record confidential.**

Government Code section 7922.000 allows for withholding documents when the public interest served by not making the records public clearly outweighs the public interest served by their disclosure. The redacted portions of the Project Support Agreement contain proprietary information related to the parties' negotiations regarding community benefits. The discussion of the monetary amounts constitutes commercially sensitive and valuable information that the parties have agreed should be kept confidential, as evidenced by the confidentiality provision of the Agreement. Maintaining the confidentiality of the redacted information aligns with the public interest in fostering discussions and negotiations regarding charitable agreements. Further, there is no harm to the public interest in maintaining the confidentiality of the redacted provisions. The Applicant will be docketing a redacted version of the Agreement, which allows the public to see a general discussion of the Agreement's terms and conditions regarding community benefits.

Government Code section 7927.400 et seq. generally allows for the withholding of personal information. This provision supports the redaction of contact information in

the Agreement. Government Code section 7922.000 also supports the redaction of contact information. Disclosure of contact information serves no public interest, while redaction protects important privacy rights.

**6. State whether the record may be disclosed if it is aggregated with other information or masked to conceal certain portions (including but not limited to the identity of the applicant). State the degree of aggregation or masking required. If the data cannot be disclosed even if aggregated or masked, explain why.**

The information may be disclosed if it is aggregated with other information. In fact, the information is aggregated and summarized in the Project's Community Benefits Plan and in the Draft Staff Assessment that has been posted to the docket and already is available for public review.


Additionally, as noted, a redacted version of the Agreement will be posted to the docket. The redactions are limited in scope, allowing the remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement to be reviewed by the public.

**7. State how the record is kept confidential by the applicant and whether it has ever been disclosed to a person other than an employee of the applicant. If it has, explain the circumstances under which disclosure occurred.**

The redacted information has not been disclosed to a person other than an employee or representative of Levy Alameda, LLC, and the counterparty of the executed agreement.
