To the Commissioners and Staff of the California Energy Commission,

On behalf of Keep Vacaville Safe, we respectfully request a few adjustments to the upcoming public hearing in which the Staff Assessment for the Corby Project Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) will be presented.

**1. Please schedule the public comment portion of the hearing after 5:00 p.m.** Our community includes many working residents who are unable to attend meetings held during standard work hours. At the previous public hearing, several individuals reported that the meeting concluded before they were able to arrive. Ensuring that public comment begins after 5:00 p.m. would allow the most participation and help ensure that the hearing reflects the full range of community perspectives.

**2. Please enable the “Raise Hand” feature during the Zoom portion of the meeting.** Multiple community members informed us that although they were able to watch the last hearing via Zoom, the “Raise Hand” function was disabled, preventing them from offering public comment. For residents who cannot attend in person, this feature is essential for equitable access and meaningful engagement.

**3. Additionally, we would like to request 3 paper copies of the staff assessment.** We would appreciate these copies to be brought to the public hearing and one of our members can collect them.

Our goal is to ensure that all members of the Vacaville community, especially those with work, family, or mobility constraints, have a fair opportunity to participate in this important process. We appreciate the Commission’s commitment to transparency and public involvement, and we believe these adjustments will strengthen that commitment.
