The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a staff webinar on proposed approaches for investigating opportunities to integrate non-energy impacts<sup>1</sup> (NEIs) in supply modeling. This workshop is part of CEC's Informational Proceeding on Non-Energy Impacts (Benefits and Social Costs). The proceeding is CEC's public process serving as a forum to determine methodologies to integrate into CEC planning processes and decision making. This webinar will seek public input on proposed metrics to be evaluated.

## Background

In response to a petition<sup>2</sup> filed February 5, 2024, by a group of sixteen petitioners (the Center for Biological Diversity et al.), the CEC adopted the NEI OIIP in March 2024 under Docket No. 24-OIIP-03. The purpose of this Order Instituting an Informational Proceeding (OIIP) is to initiate a transparent public process to serve as a forum to inform methodologies to integrate non-energy impacts (benefits and social costs) into CEC planning processes and decision making, including in electric system resource planning. Including non-energy benefits and social costs provides a more holistic understanding of the implications of investments and decisions.
