Dear Christine Seal:

This letter is to notify you that under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1879, CEC staff will extend the time to issue the staff assessment (SA), which includes the draft environmental impact report (EIR), by 30 days so that staff can complete its analysis and bring the matter to the CEC for consideration as soon as practicable.

On March 3, 2026, the applicant filed a request (TN 268909) to extend the 270-day period for the CEC to determine whether to certify the EIR and issue a certificate for the project by an additional 62 days, or until Monday, September 14, 2026. On March 16, 2026, CEC staff granted the extension request (TN 269226), noting that the timeline may be further adjusted if necessary.

CEC staff is now adjusting the extension. The updated date for filing the SA is June 15, 2026. This new timeline will be reflected in the CEC's Opt-In Certification Dashboard, available on the CEC's Opt-In Program Webpage, at <https://www.energy.ca.gov/programs-andtopics/topics/power-plants/opt-certification-program>.
