Update  
@everyone

CEC isn't finished with their staff assessment and preliminary decision on the Corby BESS. They extended their deadline to 6/15.

If you still want to submit comments asking them to reject Corby here's your chance!

Here's some talking points:

- Corby doesn't follow our zoning policy. The land is exclusively agricultural. A Bess doesn't belong
- Corby brings new serious safety and health concerns that are unacceptable to our community
- There isn't enough economic benefit that would outweigh the risks this project introduces
- Solano County has a BESS Ordinance that would allow Corby in an industrial zone, but NextEra doesn't want to move their project.
- Our community would accept the Corby Project in an appropriate location such as Lambie Industrial Park. Not on protected agricultural lands.

Please consider not approving the CORBY BESS project if the above conditions are not met.
