Respectfully Requesting an Immediate moratorium on RB Inyokern Data center

I am a resident of Inyokern and a concerned citizen. While I believe in the importance of advancing in technology such as A I., I believe MORE in the rights of residents to be able to have access to what they need in their homes and live free of pollution, whether it's noise, light, water or air. Not in my home please.

The RB Inyokern Project presents significant concerns regarding water usage, cooling methods, and the lack of transparent communication with the public and I'm it's application filings. In a region already facing water limitations, it is unacceptable that clear, detailed information about water demand, sourcing, and long-term impacts has not been fully disclosed. Additionally, the project's cooling methods typically a major driver of water consumption have not been explained in a manner that allows for meaningful understanding or evaluation. What were being told and what were reading in these documents do not match.

This lack of clarity prevents informed community input and raises serious environmental concerns. Equally troubling is the pattern of incomplete or misleading information.

Transparency is essential to public trust, yet the current process has left residents uncertain and inadequately informed. Public engagement must be genuine and grounded in full disclosure, not limited or obscured communication. Finally, there is a clear absence of demonstrated community support. Concerns raised by residents have not been sufficiently addressed, and proceeding without that support undermines the integrity of the decision-making process. For these reasons, I respectfully urge that the RB Inyokern Project be paused or denied until full transparency is achieved and community concerns are meaningfully addressed.
