The Silicon Valley Leadership Group, on behalf of our member companies, is pleased to support the proposed 2013 update to Title 24, Part 6 – California's Energy Efficiency Standards for Residential and Nonresidential Buildings. If adopted and approved by the California Energy Commission and the California Building Standards Commission, the 2013 Standards are a cost-effective way to achieve a 30 percent energy savings improvement from the 2008 Standards.

A key policy priority of the Leadership Group is to drive energy efficiency standards and technologies.
