The Silicon Valley Leadership Group, on behalf of our member companies, is pleased to support the proposed 2013 update to Title 24, Part 6 – California’s Energy Efficiency Standards for Residential and Nonresidential Buildings. If adopted and approved by the California Energy Commission and the California Building Standards Commission, the 2013 Standards are a cost-effective way to achieve a 30 percent energy savings improvement from the 2008 Standards.

A key policy priority of the Leadership Group is to drive energy efficiency standards and technologies. The Leadership Group recognizes California’s energy efficiency standards during the past 35 years have yielded more than \$29 billion in electricity savings to California consumers while also ensuring the state’s energy consumption per capita has remained relatively constant.
